- Brakes must work
- All competing vehicles must have working seat belts or racing harness. All drivers must also wear a DOT approved full-face helmet. Helmet strap must be fastened. All drivers must wear protective clothing long sleeve shirts/jackets, pants and closed toes shoes or boots are required. Fire retardant jacket, pants, shoes and gloves are highly recommended.
- No suspension modifications are allowed
- Tires can be any dot approved tire
- You may cut fenders for clearance
- Must clean car or truck of loose debris
- Battery must be strapped down securely.
- Gas tanks must be securely attached to the vehicle.
- Roll over protection recommended.
- All contestants are responsible for disabling all air bags in their vehicle, if so equipped.
- No Alcohol or Drug Use, Drivers must be 18 or older

An Eagle Raceway Official will inspect vehicles before the races. We reserve the right to not let you compete if your vehicle is not deemed safe to compete in any way or if it is over built. There will be a pit meeting for competitors at 5:15. Tuff Truck competitors should park their vehicles in the very North overflow pit lot.

Object of event: Driver with fastest time on a short off road course wins. Off road course includes small jumps.
